3. HAZARDS IDENTIFICATION

Health Effects: Irritating to the eyes, respiratory system and skin

4. FIRST AID MEASURES

General: Keep the affected person warm and at rest. Get prompt medical attention

First Aid – Eyes: Rinse immediately with plenty of water for 15 min's. Should irritation persist, seek medical advice.

First Aid – Skin: Wash immediately with plenty of warm soapy water

First Aid – Ingestion: Give copious amounts of water or milk to drink. Seek medical advice. DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING

First Aid – Inhalation: Move immediately to fresh air. Seek medical advice.

5. FIRE FIGHTING MEASURES

If involved in a fire, keep containers cool, ensure that water run-off is not allowed to enter water-courses or drains.

6. ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES

To clean the floor and all objects use inert absorbent material – wash area with water. Should not be washed into drains unless it leads to a suitable effluent treatment process.

7. HANDLING AND STORAGE

Storage: Keep at ambient temperature in original capped container, away from direct sources of light & heat – PROTECT FROM FROST.

Handling: Handle & open containers with care to avoid spillages. Avoid constant or repeated skin contact.
